TAKE 70 (OR 40/61) TO 61, TO 218 (OR 394 FROM 61 TO 218 IF OPEN), AND 218/380 TO 20 (NEAR WATERLOO), BACK ONTO 218 THROUGH AUSTIN, MN ALL THE WAY UP TO 35 (NEAR OWATONNA) AND 35 THE REST OF THE WAY TO BLOOMINGTON, MN.

THIS ROUTE WAS USED BEFORE X-MAS AND DRIVING TIME WAS 9 1/2 HOURS. WE HAVE MADE THE DRIVE SEVERAL TIMES, SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT, GOING INTO MINNEAPOLIS AND USUALLY MAKE IT IN ABOUT 9. HOURS, IT IS RECOMMENDED OF COURSE, THAT MAPS ARE USED.

As of February 1, 1966, all bodies have been built incorporating anchorage provisions (anchor nuts) for the installation of front seat shoulder straps, on both the driver and passenger sides of the vehicle. As of March 1, 1966, front seat shoulder straps became available as factory or dealer installed options.



THE RISE AND FALL

Safety concerns, emissions/bumper and insurance regulations hit all the 1970 crop of Detroit cars, particularly performance cars like Pontiac's GTO. GM seems to be amongst the first to buckle under to such governmental pressure. The GTO folk turned their attention from tripower and cams to handling considerations for 1970. This was not entirely without justification since their mighty muscle car was skimming along on old fashioned, 70-series skinny rubber and didn't sport a sway bar at either end.

The 1970 remedy for these deficiencies was the addition of a %-inch rear sway bar. A thicker bar and an optional handling package was available on the GTO models and was composed of front and rear stabilizer bars of 1%-inch diameter each, as well as by G60-15 tires, wide 15 x 7 wheels, high rate springs, heavy duty shocks, and variable ratio power steering.

In the boiler room, the 1970 GTO fared fairly well. The Ram Air IV engine was a limited production option. The Ram Air III was also available on dealer order blanks, and retained its 366 horsepower rating at 5100 rpm. That left the standard GTO engine, which was a 400-cube, 4-barrel affair with 10.25-to-1 pistons, rated at 350 hp at 5000 rpm.



Before the end of 1970, the Ram Air III and the Ram Air IV engines were dropped from the GTO lineup. The scramble for goodie GTO parts and pieces had begun. To replace these two Ram Air engines, Pontiac made the optional engine for 1970 a 455 cu. in. unit with 360 horsepower. In actuality, this 455 was a bored and stroked, but lower performance, version of the 400. So GTO stalwarts were left with 360 hp at a low 4300 rpm, but with a fairly encouraging and hefty 500 lbs./ft. of torque at 2700 rpm.

Low compression ratio was the name of the game in 1971. There was no way around it. Ratios were lowered across the board by all manufacturers, both to meet the new emissions regulations from the Muskie group in Congress, and because the gas was really crappy low octane near-waterd, it could not support the high compression ratios of the super muscle car era. But the Pontiac whizkids, led by DeLorean. Wangers, and Estes, decided to pull off one more coup before the shift hit the fan in '71. Remember, these dudes loved performance cars and especially performance Pontiacs.

They concocted a really strange but very effective—brew this time. Just before the end of the 1970 model run they unleashed the best, most powerful Poncho engine yet, The Ram Air V. The Ram Air V was optional for installations in the 1970 GTO. The cylinder heads were wild with round intake and round exhaust ports for sewer like flow, 780 Holley quad on an aluminum high-rise manifold, solid lifter cam with 308/320-degree duration. and a race beefed block with thick webbing and very strong, wide connecting rods. This Ram Air V was strictly not a factory installed engine, but you could order one over the parts counter.




