

JANUARY 1992 GOAT OF THE MONTH


This Cardinal Red 1970 GTO Convertible belongs to Vic Nettle. Vic purchased it new from Charles Vincel Pontiac for \$2350 and the trade-in of his 1967 GTO Convertible. It started out as just a hunt for a new car. Vic looked at the Z-28, W-30, Challenger and GTO. The decision to purchase the GTO came because Vic considered the fact that his '67 was three years old and he had no problems with it. Vic got a total trade-in price on his '67 of \$1500. It seems that at this time he was not a multi car owner. I knew Vic then and would have loved to have his '67 but I was only 17 and to withdrawn to say anything.

Vic has experimented with several engines, first a 400, then a 455, then a SD455. Presently it has a 455 bored .060", making it a 468 cubic inch, with SD 455 heads.



Vic purchased the GTO with a white rag top and crank windows. In 1986 when the GTO was in need of a restoration Vic decided to replace the top with a black one, much to my disapproval. Since the change I have come to like the black. Vic also added power windows, a driver's floor vent, removal of marker lights, a Red Bird steering wheel and 1978 Trans Am 8" wheels.

The GTO was completely disassembled by Al Rothweiler at his house during his spare time. When I say disassembled, I mean body off frame and nuts and bolts all over. We had all fasteners, hood hinges, anti-sway bars, backing plates, and spindles cadmium plated. We purchased a stainless steel exhaust system and had it polished. We installed stainless steel body bolts. The restoration took approximately 10 months of working almost every night with Vic and me helping. We would go over and clean and burn off undercoating, run for parts and just give Al moral support. There were a few times when Al got kind of burnt out that he really needed a lot of moral support. Once the GTO was all back together and in primer, Al could see the light at the end of the tunnel.



We took the car to Turk's Auto Body in Arnold and used his paint booth. All put three gallons of Ditzler Lacquer on the car then baked it for 60 minutes. He sanded it with 1200 grit paper, buffed it and it was off to Cervantes Convention Center. We got in the 25th Annual Cervantes Show just under the rope. We were happy to be selected for the show and went away with a First Place trophy in our class.

To date, the GTO has power windows, power brakes, power steering, air conditioning, 12 bolt 3.55:1 differential, turbo 400 with variable pitch torque converter, dual 4 barrel carburetors and cruise control. It does the quarter mile in 13.5 seconds at 107 mph.






