

PREZ SCOOP

Hello Everyone,

If you plan to attend the MAR opening event March 30th please call them at 314-673-2434. This is just to give them an idea of the crowd to expect. Admission is \$8.00 and of course, weather permitting. Expect a big crowd if its nice weather.

To bring your Pontiac out, just take HW 70 west to the Pearce Blvd. exit. Turn right and follow the signs to the track. The club usually pits in the field to the left of the participants entrance.

Some basic rules are: All drivers must wear long pants and a shirt. All cars must remove any trim rings or hub caps. You must have 2 throttle return springs, a 16 oz. Min. radiator overflow bottle (even if its temporary), and a seat belt. Any shifter that is not OEM must have a reverse lockout, and batteries must be bolted down, and if they're in the trunk, you must have a master kill switch. At 13.49 convertibles require a roll bar, helmet and 3 inch belt. Cars with slicks need a drive shaft loop. 13.00 street tire w/ DOT soft compound need a drive shaft loop also. 11.99 or faster need a rollbar, 3 inch harness, jacket, and if you have a clutch, it must meet spec.'s and be shielded. Helmets required with any rollbar or cage and track rules can require them any time if they want.
