
Gateway GTO Club Information:

The Hummbler 1970 GTO

Since 1964 the GTO had lead the pack. When 1970 rolled around the direction of the pack was unclear, PMD knew this, with a steady 10% decreace in sales between 1968 and 1969, pontiac management could see the trend-pontiac was in trouble. For whatever consololation it might be, the total industry sales were off also, but Pontiac was off double the national average. The GTO still enjoyed a lead over Buick GS and Olds 442 but even that wasn't anything to shout about. Total sales for 1970 GTO was 40,149 units. The 1970 GTO was out sold by every previous GTO except the very first year-1964. The GTO as well as the other Muscle cars were experiencing 3 major foes. the Insurance industry, uncle sam, an in the case of the GTO, Pontiac top GM management themselves. They classed GTO's or any mucle car as a class 1, which ment a 50-100% rate increase on a 1970 or newer mucle car. The director of the national highway safety bureau was quoted saying " The way the auto industry's pushing mucle cars borders on criminal irresponsiblity." Top GM management wasn't offering any encoragement either. Both the GM pres. and the chairman of the board stated there had been to much emphasis...

placed on the youthmarket and were very critical of what they described as "Hip" ads which used such terms as "Ponies" instead of horsepower and "Cubes instead of cubic inches. The overall Pontiac reputation was cleary dependent on the welfare of the GTO. It had become thier status symbol, and overall none of the 1970 pontiacs were very well recieved. Add to this another price increace (about \$120) and sales tumbled. Even with all the problems the GTO faced there was some new features that were worth noting. The body had been restyled the GTO got a new endura bumper, the radio antenna was now in the winsheild, The Judge package was continued and would be avalible in several wild colors, the ram air III and ram air IV was carried over from 1969, a new engine was offered the which brought engine/transmission combinations to eleven. Very late in the year an engine option was offered through your Pontiac dealers parts department, it was, as we all know the ram air V package. One other option that alway's will stand out for 1970 was the vacuum operated exhaust. Overall the 1970 GTO was restyled into what some think was one of the best looking GTO to



date. Several other first for 1970 were the formula steering wheel, the rear sway bar, side impact door beams and the return of the exposed headlights. The Judge option had new strips and a new wing on the deck lid, which did not offer much in the way of performance, but did turn heads on the blvd. For 1970 all the name plates were dropped from the car and replaced with decal's, with the exception of the grill. With this, along with the styling changes the GTO had a new and distinctive look, a mature sense. The GTO was still a very impressive car, and it did make driving fun.

In 1969 with the departure of the two key men associated with the GTO, John DeLorean, and Jim Wanagers, there was little hope the GTO would be able to survive in the new decade. Both of these men were crucial to the GTO. It's not possible to overemphasize how important they were to the development and the success of the GTO. A person only has to look at the sales figure to see this.

There are many thing's that I like about the 1970 GTO, as well as the other year's and I hope to bring you a few point's that we can share about these car's that we all love with a passion, till next time, enjoy your pure Pontiac. Steve Hedrick....




