Saturday of labor day weekend in Auburn is the classic car cruise for Auburns, Cords and Duisenberg's, period. No other cars allowed. For those of you who don't remember or know, these cars are vintage 20s and 30s, don't believe anything exists from the 40s. This cruise event is a parade of these cars down main street and the surrounding neighborhoods. People set up lawn chairs along the streets to watch the parade of cars. The parade usually lasts about an hour and a half. In this parade you see a continuous flow of the old cars. After the parade, the head-quarters of the Auburn Car Co. is within walking distance and is open for visitors. This again is the headquarters and also an old showroom for the cars. It is really something to see. You can spend hours walking through this auto museum.

After the parade, just down the road is the Kruse International Auction grounds. Over this weekend and the week preceding labor day every year is a consecutive day auto auction/swap meet event. In one day, 75,000 people attend this event with several thousand cars to see. What makes this event so much fun is that you can actually sit and watch the auction or at your leisure walk the grounds and see everything that is for sale. Here you see a tremendous variety of cars. In the swap meet area, the grounds are so large and packed that people actually use golf carts to cover the event.
