Tech Article- Fan Relay on New GTOs



Tech Article on Fan Relay Sticking on New Gen GTOs


Not long ago, I had the GTO out on a hot day with the AC running. We stopped at a gas station and noticed that even though the ignition was off, the fan was still running. I had never noticed it do that before. I watched it for a while and eventually it turned off.

I noticed it do it a few more times, and started to wonder if a relay was sticking. I talked to Brian O'Sullivan about it and he had been having a similar issue. He confirmed it was a relay sticking causing his problem and even told me that when it would stick, he would just tap the relay a few times to break it loose.

I pulled out the service manuals and found the schematic for the fans and determined that the Low Speed Fan Relay was the most likely culprit. This relay is located in the relay/fuse panel located under the hood on the passenger side fender well. The relay in question is a GM Part number 92092445 relay located in about the middle of the panel.



There is a diagram on the inside of the cover of the panel to help you identify the fuses and relays by location:



With the suspect relay located, I waited for the next time the fan was running with the igni-


tion off and popped the cover off the panel and pulled the relay out. As soon as I did, the fan stopped running. Expecting that this would be the case, I had ordered some replacement relays and had one in the glove box. I popped in a new relay and that has been the end of that problem for my '04.

Not being one to just let something like that go, I decided to do a bit of failure analysis on the relay to see what was driving the issue. The relay in question is a relay made by Tyco Electronics. They make a lot of commercial, automotive, and aerospace grade relays. This particular relay is from their automotive line


The info in the lower right hand corner tells us that the relay was manufactured at the plant in India. (IN). We also know that it was manufactured on the 30th week of 2004. (0430 is electrical date coding - first 2 digit are the calendar year, the second 2 digits are the week). This puts it at around mid July of 2004. This matches up for a car that was assembled in August of 2004.



Unlike aerospace grade relays, which are typically hermetically sealed, automotive grade relays are at best environmentally sealed. So, de-lidding this device was a simple matter of using a small screw driver to pop off the cover. Once inside, the failure mode was obvious. The normally open contact set was badly pitted with obvious signs of material transfer from the movable contact to the stationary contact. The normally closed contact set, however, looked almost pristine.




Further disassembly by removing the armature confirmed that the movable contact side had significant material transfer. This was causing the normally open contact to weld itself shut, resulting in the fan running even when the body control module was not calling for it by energizing the relay.





Tech Article- Fan Relay on New GTOs





This sort of damage in a relatively short time frame (I have about 35,000 miles) suggests that this relay's motor load rating is simply not high enough for the fan motors it is driving. So, my suggestion for those that have this problem is to buy a new relay and swap it out. The relays are readily available from Rock Auto by the GM part number (92092445) for just over \$20. Even better, the swap only takes about 1 minute. Of course, it is going to fail again, but for \$20, it is easy enough to keep one in the glove box ready for next time.




