Gateway GTO Co-Hosts GTOAA National Convention in Springfield, Missouri

Gateway GTO Co-Hosted the GTOAA National Convention this year with our sister chapter the GR-RRR8'R Wichita GTO Club. I think we were all hoping for a smooth event given the way the 2023 convention was ended early, and we got it.

Most of the Gateway members rolled in on Monday or Tuesday and we got right to work. Terry Schott and Ron Wildebrandt got to work executing their plan for the trailer parking. The net result was the most organized and efficient trailer parking set up we ever had at a national convention. Every owner could access their trailer and their tow vehicle and even use the trailer as a garage in case the weather would threaten rain or storms. As it turns out, the weather, which was just a bit on the warm side, especially later in the week, was otherwise perfect. No rain. No storms. In fact most days there were barely any clouds.

The registration got underway on schedule Tuesday morning with Gateway members Terrie Oxler, Diana Johnson, and Paula Winslow working with a few others to keep the process running smoothly.

Outside, there was no tent this year. The Tech area was at the side entrance to the hotel, which had its own cover that was part of the building.

However, this year Gateway members Lucas Hedrick and Bryan Johnson helped Tom with the idea that they will be taking this over. With all of the help, the two car shows, the indoor judged show and the outdoor popular vote show went off without a hitch. All of this led us to the two big events for the week. The Groovy Ballroom Bash on Friday and the Awards Banquet on Saturday.

The Groovy Ballroom Bash theme was the idea of Terrie Oxler and her vision came to life on Friday when we all entered the event. The centerpiece of the evening, however, was the live band sponsored by Gateway GTO, Captain Rat and the Blind Rivets. This is the first live band that we had at a GTOAA parking lot party since the last time Gateway hosted a convention. In short, it was a HUGE success. The final event of the night was the retirement of Vic as our president and the start of our own John Johnson as the new president of GTOAA.


I could not be more proud of how all of Gateway stepped up to make this event a huge success. There isn't another club in GTOAA that has the impact on the organization that Gate-




