Welcome to 2025! With the 12 inches of snow that we got up here in O'Fallon, it will be a good long while before either of my Pontiacs see the roads. They are currently tucked in under their dust covers with the battery tenders running. Hopefully Easter will be here before we know it......

In the mean time, we already have some events lined up for 2025. First up will be our annual pinball wizard tournament at Atomic Pinball. We have that set for March 2nd. I have included the flyer in this newsletter. Be sure to let Marty know if you are coming by <u>February 16th</u> so he can get a good head count. This tournament is open to our friends and families too, so feel free to invite them as well. The cost is \$15 per person. We will be heading out for a group dinner afterward for anyone that is interested.

Marty has also arranged for a private event at the Coke Museum in St. Charles on March 15th. This event will run from 8:30pm to 10:30pm and will include pizza. The cost is \$15 per person. We will need about 20 people to make the numbers work, so if you are planning to come and have not already let me know, please do so as soon as possible.

We also have the annual St. Patrick's Day dance on March 29th. More details to follow on that as the event gets closer, but it has always been a lot of fun and it raises money to support the Semper Fi Fund and Toys for Tots, so it is for great causes.

The other thing we will be talking about a lot over the next few months is the Wheels in Motion car show that will take place on May 17th at the Church on the Rock. This will be a new location and the first time that this show will occur twice in the same year. We will have both this spring event and then later we will have the show in the fall in our usual September time slot. This show will also be at the Church on the Rock. Gateway will only be organizing a raffle for the fall show. For both shows we will be taking money as the cars enter and then helping with parking if needed. I have included the flyer for the May show in this newsletter. This new location, by the way, was Earl's idea and he brought everyone together to make it happen.

One other item to cover this month, since it is January, is our annual financial statement. I have it attached on the next page. We started 2024 with \$17297.29 and ended it with \$16609.52. All things considered that is not too bad. We would probably have actually ended the year with a net gain had there been a higher attendance at the GTOAA convention. That said, we do need to take a good look at the Christmas party moving forward. That is by far our biggest event. For 2024 it cost us over \$2400 to put on, but we only took in \$1025. So, for 2025, we may need to look at increasing the cost of attending.

Finally, 2025 is an election year for Gateway, so we will be looking for people to run for the officer positions so please consider running.


